NOTICE TO TEAM CAPTAINS/MANAGERS REGARDING ADVICE TO COMPETITORS

Concerns were raised during the General Technical Meeting about the condition to prohibit the provision of any advice to competitors. We committed during the meeting that we would discuss these concerns to the International Governing Body, which we have.

Given the nature of this matter however an immediate official determination is not possible therefore on the basis that advice has been allowed in the Universiade in the past, and that teams will have travelled to Taiwan assuming this condition would be again in place at the 2017 event, we have decided that the following condition will apply for the 2017 Summer Universiade:

“Each team may appoint one person who may give advice to members of that team. Such person must be identified to the Committee before giving advice.”

Notes:

- This allowance will also apply for countries who do not have a team entered in the team event.
- One advisor per team (men and women) is permitted.
- This allowance will continue to apply for any competitor in a play-off for an individual event medal.
- Each country must register with the FISU TD the name of the person who will be entitled to give advice.
- Each person registered to give advice will be provided with identification to be displayed on the course during competition rounds.
